

PO 220.11: Withdrawing an Appeal

PR 220.11.

The client or their representative may withdraw the appeal at any time during the appeal process until the final hearing decision is issued. **The withdrawal of an appeal must always be in writing.**

If the representative has Power of Attorney, the client cannot withdraw the appeal without their consent, except in one instance: during the appeal hearing if the representative is not present and the client wants to withdraw the appeal, the withdrawal can be accepted.
