The conference APP works on any phone, tablet or device (including laptop/desktop computers). Follow these easy instructions for using the application:

- Log into the download center / app store on your device
- Find the APP under the name "TOI CONFER-ENCE"
- Download to your device
- Sign in and register with an email and password of your choice
