- Not setting personal goals
- Not prioritizing tasks
- Failing to manage distractions 4)

- 6) Taking on too much and not learning to say "no"
- Thriving on being busy, rather than producing 7)
- Multitasking
- Not taking breaks
- 10) Scheduling tasks ineffectually
